It is great to see Room 8 students working hard on their learning this term. We begin each day with focussed Talking, Writing and Reading until 9:30am. Students are keen to show how well they can write exciting stories.

In our English block we are working to complete the Australian curriculum expectations for Year 3. This week all students will review the goals they have reached and set new goals for their ILPs (Independent Learning Plans).

In Mathematics we are also working on the Year 3 curriculum: adding numbers and finding the difference between them; working out how long to cut pieces of string; and reading and writing times.





We have learned about our own Port Augusta Community and Country. First we looked towards future power generation. Then we imagined what it would have been like to live here before 1800, and the changes that occurred after that. We can see what people did here in the 1800s by looking at the buildings and photos and stories that people have written. We have used Art-work and much reading, writing and mathematics to learn about people in Port Augusta's past. A hike up Dutchmans Stern will give us a lot more information about our locality as well.
